## THE FALMOUTH THEATRE GUILD WILLIAM STEELE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The **Falmouth Theatre Guild William Steele Memorial Scholarship** is open to any graduating high school student of the **Falmouth, Bourne, & Mashpee** communities, or an active member of the Falmouth Theatre Guild who is planning a career in the arts and has been accepted to an accredited four-year college. This year, the scholarship will be a minimum of \$1,000. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient. The FTG Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will submit its recommendation to the FTG Board of Directors for final approval.

## THE FALMOUTH THEATRE GUILD IRENE THIBEAULT SPIRIT of FTG SCHOLARSHIP

The Falmouth **Theatre Guild Irene Thibeault Spirit of FTG Scholarship** is open to any graduating high school student of the **Falmouth, Bourne, & Mashpee** communities, or an active member of the Falmouth Theatre Guild who has given the Guild their time, involvement, and dedication, and been accepted to an accredited four-year institution of higher learning. This year, the scholarship will be a minimum of \$1,000. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient. The FTG Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will submit its recommendation to the FTG Board of Directors for final approval.

The applicant will be judged on the following merits:

1. Scholastic record.
2. Interest and effort in preparing for their vocation.
3. Extracurricular activities, including Guild participation.
4. Personal recommendations.

In order for your application to be considered, it **must** include the following:

1. A transcript of high school grades through the second quarter of your senior year. If mailed, the transcript must be in a sealed envelope from your guidance counselor.
2. A letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or other member of the high school faculty.
3. Additional recommendations from two (2) responsible members of the community who are familiar with your ability and character.
4. A certificate of acceptance at an accredited four-year institution as a freshman. If this is not available, the certificate of acceptance must be accepted when received.
5. A recent photograph to appear in official FTG recognitions of our scholarship recipients.

Completed applications should be returned by **March 25, 2025**. Do not delay in forwarding all of the necessary materials.

The actual awarding of the scholarships takes place in the second semester of the recipient's freshman college year, and the recipient **must** furnish a first semester transcript from the college to the FTG Scholarship Committee Chair.
